RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF
LINCOLN UNIVERSITY HISTORIC DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Lincoln University Heritage Initiative (“LUHI”) has been formed by a group of Lincoln University alumni interested in assisting Lincoln University to obtain national recognition of the 15 oldest buildings on the campus on the National Register of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the 15 buildings were deemed eligible for recognition as the Lincoln University Historic District on January 4, 1985, by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission; and

WHEREAS, the 15 buildings eligible for the LU Historic District are:

1. Azikiwe-Nkrumah Hall (1865)
2. Lincoln Hall (1866)
3. Alumni House (1870)
4. Cresson Hall (1870)
5. Cannon House (1874)
6. Houston Hall (1881)
7. Mary Dod Brown Chapel (1890)
8. University Hall (1891)
9. Bond House (1891)
10. Vail Hall (1899)
11. Amos Hall (1902)
12. McCauley Hall (1904)
13. President’s House (1906)
14. Life Sciences Building (1925)
15. Rendell Hall (1931)

WHEREAS, an application will be submitted to the National Park Service to designate said historical district;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION OF LINCOLN UNIVERSITY PA (“AALU”) that the association:

Article 1. Endorses the submission of the nomination of the 15 said buildings for recognition on the National Register of Historic Places;

Article 2. Agrees to participate in the development and financial support of the proposed LU Historic District as AALU determines appropriate;

Article 3. Endorses the goal of economic development of the historic district within the context of preservation and rehabilitation of the historic buildings;

Article 4. Endorses the goal of tourism development of the historic district within the context of contribution to the overall visitor development goals of the university; and

Article 5. Encourages members of AALU to support the development of the historic district and to help create, promote and maintain activities and events in the district upon its creation.
